



ADIRONDACK DRUG TASK FORCE

Clinton County District Attorney Andrew J. Wylie announced today that the Adirondack Drug Task Force arrested Timothy W. Ellis and Miguel J. Jackson on March 27, 2009, in the early morning hours, upon charges of possession of crack cocaine and heroin.

Timothy W. Ellis dob: 02/04/1981, residing in Effort, Pennsylvania is charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance Third Degree and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance Fourth Degree. The New York State Police conducted a road stop of a 1991 Oldsmobile motor vehicle in the Town of Plattsburgh on Interstate 87 northbound being operated by Ellis. The vehicle and its occupants were searched resulting in the recovery of approximately 50 grams of crack cocaine and 40 bindles of heroin. The defendant was processed at S.P. Plattsburgh. Ellis was arraigned in Plattsburgh City Court this morning. The defendant entered a plea of not guilty and the case was transferred to the Town of Plattsburgh Justice Court with a return date of March 30, 2009.

Judge Clute set bail in the amount of \$50,000 cash or \$100,000 bond. The defendant is represented by Marcia Moss, Esq., of Chazy, New York.



Miguel J. Jackson dob: 11/02/1987, residing in Brooklyn, New York, is charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance Third Degree and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance Fourth Degree. The New York State Police conducted a road stop of a 1991 Oldsmobile motor vehicle in the Town of Plattsburgh on Interstate 87 northbound. Jackson was a front seat passenger in the vehicle. The vehicle and its occupants were searched resulting in the recovery of approximately 50 grams of crack cocaine and 40 bindles of heroin. Jackson was arraigned in Plattsburgh City Court this morning. The defendant entered a plea of not guilty and the case was



transferred to the Town of Plattsburgh Justice Court with a return date of March 30, 2009. Judge Clute set bail in the amount of \$30,000 cash or \$60,000 bond. The defendant is represented by Mike Phillips, Esq., of Rouses Point, New York.

The approximate street value of the heroin is \$2,000.00 and the crack cocaine is \$10,000.00
