Chairperson Henry called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m.

Kim Kinblom, the Deputy County Administrator, conducted roll call. Legislator Waldron asked to be excused.

Legislator Hall motioned to accept the minutes of the March 12, 2025 Regular Session, seconded by Legislator Bezio. Carried (9-0-1).

Chairperson Henry asked if anyone wished to address the Legislature.

Jennifer Jewett, of Champlain, New York, was the only individual in the audience that wished to address the Legislature. Chairperson Henry stated there was nothing on the agenda addressing the proposed dog tethering law and did not grant Ms. Jewett the privilege of the floor. Ms. Jewett replied that is not correct, that Mr. Henry cannot ban her from speaking. Chairperson Henry stated Ms. Jewett is out of order as she has not been called on.

There being no one else who wished to address the Legislature, Chairperson Henry moved onto the Committee Reports.

Buildings and Grounds Committee – Legislator Lamoy

Legislator Lamoy stated the Buildings and Grounds Committee has not met since the last Regular Session.

There being no further business, Chairperson Henry moved on to resolutions. The following resolutions were approved unless otherwise noted.


Resolutions #201 through #206 were approved.
