WHEREAS, on March 8, 2026, C & S Engineers, Inc. offered a reduction in the overall contract amount for this Project from \$433,400 to \$425,000, removing the associated DBE certified participation costs from their contract; and

WHEREAS, prior to the execution of the contract, it was determined that the contract must be revised to reduce the cost from \$433,400 to \$425,000, contingent upon FAA approval; now, therefore,
