**Narrative:** After receiving helpful information and assistance from the public, deputies from the Clinton County Sheriff's Office were able to successfully complete the investigation regarding the motor vehicle crash that occurred at the intersection of Route 374 and Quarry Road in the Town of Plattsburgh on January 20, 2026. Based on the investigation, it was determined that Brent Denis was traveling East on State Route 374 and entered the intersection with Quarry Road in the path of Diana Giambruno, who was traveling North on Quarry Road. As a result, Giambruno's vehicle struck Denis's vehicle, causing it to roll onto its side.

**Disposition:** On the date of the crash, Giambruno was transported to UVM-CVPH for further evaluation after complaining of chest and wrist pain but has since been released. The Sheriff's Office was assisted by District 3 Fire Department, Beekmantown Fire Department, CVPH EMS and New York State Police. Denis was issued a traffic ticket for passing a red signal. The Sheriff's Office would like to express our sincere thanks to the public for all assistance and information provided.
