NARRATIVE: On the above date and time, the Clinton County Sheriff Deputies responded to the intersection of Route 374 and Banker Road in the Town of Plattsburgh for a motor vehicle collision with injury. Investigation at the scene determined that Robin W. Bashaw (58F/West Chazy, NY) was operating a 2021 Chevrolet Silverado south on Banker Road when she attempted to cross over Route 374, but failed to yield the right of way to and collided with a 2021 GMC Sierra being operated by Anthony G. Leerkes (69M, Mooers, NY) eastbound on Route 374.

DISPOSITION: Bashaw and two occupants of Leerkes' vehicle were transported to UVM CVPH Medical Center for assessment and treatment of minor injuries. Bashaw was ticketed for failing to yield the right of way at a stop sign. Deputies were assisted at the scene by Morrisonville Fire Department, District 3 Fire Department and Morrisonville EMS.
