NARRATIVE: On July 18, 2024, at 8:12 AM, Clinton County Sheriff's Deputies responded to Military Turnpike in the Town of Beekmantown for a report of a two car motor vehicle accident with personal injury. Charlotte L. Hollers was traveling South on Military Turnpike when she veered into the opposing lane, sideswiping a vehicle being driven North by Barbara E. Battease. Battease was treated on scene and declined further medical treatment. A passenger in Battease's vehicle was transported to CVPH for further evaluation for complaint of head and neck pain. Hollers declined any sustaining any injury.

DISPOSITION: Hollers was issued a citation for failure to keep right. At the time of press release, Battease's passenger was being evaluated and treated for her injuries. Clinton County Sheriff's Deputies were assisted by Beekmantown Fire Department and EMS, Morrisonville Fire Department, CVPH EMS, and New York State Police.
